BILL SUMMARY

Summary Synopsis:

HB 138 amends Laws 2010, Chapter 34, Section 2 of the Sunshine Portal Act to include information about the Middle Rio Grande Conservancy District (“MRGCD”). HB 138 also adds a new section mandating that beginning no later than January 1, 2014 and on a continuing basis thereafter, the MRGCD will publish information, in a downloadable format and free for public access, about its annual operating budget for fiscal year 2014, salary schedules and policies, employee directory, monthly expenditures and revenues, outstanding contracts and inventory of all property.

After July 1, 2013, the MRGCD must work with the department of information technology to create a monthly data extract from its computer database to be published on the sunshine portal. The MRGCD must also have a link on its website to the sunshine portal.
