Synopsis:

House Bill 570 is an Act that expands the felony habitual offender sentencing guidelines (section 31-18-17 NMSA 1978) to include felony DWI/DUI convictions pursuant to section 66-08-102 NMSA 1978. In addition, the Bill maintains the current enhancements for multiple DWI/DUI convictions to be included in the felony habitual offender guideline with regard to multiple DWI/DUI convictions (felony or misdemeanor).
