**BILL SUMMARY**

Synopsis:

There are two amendments proposed to Senate Bill 418. On page 8, line 3 the word “it” is replaced by “the charter school”. Second, on page 8, lines 11 to line 16 are struck. The second amendment makes it clear that all charter schools will be required to comply with the provisions of Section 2 by the “date for declarations of candidacy for the regular school district election in 2017.”
