BILL SUMMARY

Synopsis: Senate Bill 547 amends NMSA 1978, Section 19-1-1.1 by increasing the size of the state land trusts advisory board from 7 to 11 members. Specifically, SB 547 adds: one member appointed by the governor with advice and consent of the senate; one member appointed by the speaker of the house; one member appointed by the president pro temp of the senate; and the secretary of Indian affairs or their designee.

HB 547 also amends Section 19-1-1.4 by requiring the commissioner to provide notice and hold a public meeting before entering into an exchange, sale, or auction of state lands.
