Synopsis: The Senate Rules Committee recommended a “do pass” of Senate Bill 95 on February 6, 2015, subject to some minor grammatical changes. The Committee also proposed to amend the penalty schedule outlined in Section 36, pages 49-50, to reference the penalty assessments for oversize loads used in NMSA 1978, Section 66-8-116.1.
