Dear Mr. Nelson:

This letter addresses the complaint that you filed with the Office of the Attorney General alleging that Valencia County (“the County”) violated the Inspection of Public Records Act (“IPRA”), NMSA 1978, Sections 14-2-1 to -12 (1947, as amended through 2013) in connection with your IPRA Request submitted on October 26, 2017.

With respect to your complaint, you allege that the County failed to provide you with the records you requested. We have received the County’s response, wherein Angie Womack answered all of your allegations and attached copies of correspondence they have had with you. She has stated that the County does not have the records you requested, as she informed you in her letter on November 15, 2017. I have enclosed the County’s response to this letter for you. *See, Derringer v. State, 2003-NMCA-073, 133 N.M. 721.*

I have reviewed your complaint as well as the County’s response and supporting documentation, and conclude that the County has not violated the IPRA in responding to your IPRA Request. Accordingly, we consider this matter closed. Thank you for affording our office this opportunity to be of assistance.

INSPECTION OF PUBLIC RECORDS ACT COMPLAINT FORM

Under the Inspection of Public Records Act ("IPRA"), the Office of the Attorney General ("OAG") has the discretion and authority to enforce the IPRA's provisions. NMSA 1978, § 14-2-12. Generally, the OAG reviews and issues determinations regarding whether public agencies have violated the IPRA. All IPRA complaints submitted to the OAG, including any attached materials and any correspondence regarding those complaints, are public records subject to public inspection. Additionally, IPRA complaints and determinations from the OAG may be posted on our website.

All complaints submitted to the OAG will be reviewed for potential IPRA violations. The OAG may dismiss those complaints that fall outside IPRA's purview and those for which there is no remedy available under IPRA, or forward IPRA complaints to another appropriate agency for resolution. Please note that the OAG does not represent complainants in suits against public bodies.

DENIED REQUESTS TO INSPECT PUBLIC RECORDS

- Although some records were provided, the custodian did not include a written explanation for denying the production of exempt records or for redacting confidential information from records.
- No records were provided and the records custodian did not deliver or mail a written explanation to the requester within fifteen (15) calendar days after receiving the request that included a description of the records sought, the names and titles of each person responsible for denying the request, and a description of the reasons for the denial.

NOTICE

- Public body did not post in a conspicuous location at its administrative office or on the public body's website a notice setting forth: the rights of any person to inspect the public body's public records, the public body's responsibility to make public records available for inspection, the procedures for requesting inspection of public records, the procedures for requesting copies of public records, and/or reasonable fees for copying public records

- Inspection was not allowed within three (3) business days and the public body did not timely send a written "three-day letter" to the requester explaining when the records would be available or when the public body would respond to the request.

- The public body charged fees in excess of \$1.00 per printed page for documents 11"X17" or smaller, or charged fees that exceeded the actual costs to copy the records.
- The public body did not provide a receipt upon request.

DETAILED EXPLANATION OF ALLEGED IPRA VIOLATIONS (Required): Please provide a description of the actions taken by the public body that violated the IPRA, including specific dates and why you believe the IPRA has been violated.

I have had several IPRA's over the last year delayed, and the only reason I received the records was because I followed up with the records custodian. There have been a not number of instances when I did not receive a reply within 3 days. The latest IPRA I submitted on 10/30 was only partially filled. They claim not to have ~~the~~ my blueprints, plans, or drawings of the ventilation system at the Valencia County Animal Shelter. I believe they are denying me information. Other people have had similar experiences.

It appears that they delay anyone who asks for information about animal control.

On Nov 1, I made comments about these violations at the County Commission meeting and I feel they are retaliating by not providing information. They have also served me with a criminal trespass notice which I also believe is retaliatory for exposing them.

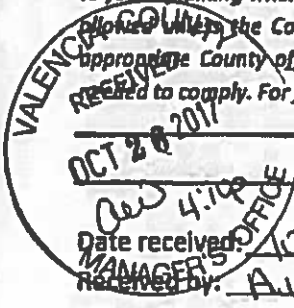
